## 10 Foundational truths from last week:

- 1. All governance belongs to God. Genesis
- 2. Any human governance is delegated by God and accountable to God. Romans 13:1
- 3. The purpose of government is to do justice by promoting good and punishing evil. I Peter 2:14
- 4. Sin distorts any human governance delegated by God. Romans 3:23
- 5. God uses governments and those who govern to accomplish His purposes and spread the Gospel. Luke 2:1-7
- 6. Governments of this world will pass away. Daniel 2:44
- 7. The perfect governance of God will one day come and will last forever. Daniel 7:13,14
- 8. Christians are dual citizens. Philippians 3:20.21
- 9. Christians are to submit to the government. Titus 3:1

10. Christians support government authority under God's authority. Mark 12:17

What are the final five foundational truths?

- 11. Christians living under government authority have two guiding commands: Love God and Love Others. Matthew 22:37-40
- 12. Allegiance to God takes priority over allegiance to the government. Acts 5:27–32
- 13. Christians will be opposed by bad governments. Matthew 10:16-25
- 14. Christians are commanded to pray for those in authority over them. I Timothy 2:1,2
- 15. Christians honor Christ by uniting around Jesus, His Word, and His church, not political parties or forms of government. John 17:20-23
